Toronto Central Toronto Cental LHIN Updates

- 1. Transition to merged LHIN/CCAC organization June 7, 2017
 - New organization structure
- 2. Primary and Community Care Committee
 - Health Links merged with primary care
 - Formed Sub-region Collaboratives for each of the 5 sub-regions
- 3. Each Sub-region collaborative has selected a priority area to focus on in the coming year
 - West Toronto: Rockcliffe-Smythe focus on chronic diseases
 - Mid West Toronto: Kensington Chinatown focus on low urgency ED visits
 - North Toronto: Mount Pleasant West focus on aloneness for a) Lone parent families and b) Seniors living alone
 - Mid-East Toronto: Moss Park focus on homelessness and mental health and addictions
 - East Toronto: Oakridge
 focus on Toronto Community Housing high needs buildings and MHA
- 4. Analysis of Toronto Community Housing high needs buillings

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- 5. Population Health and Equity Table, one of the subgroups is Needs Based health Assessment Work group (collaboration with Toronto Public Health)
- 6. Continued standardized equity data collection by hospitals and CHCs
 - Applied Health Research Questions (AHRQ) to ICES for hospitals to submit data to ICES
 - Hospitals and CHCs encouraged to use the equity data they have collected to stratify variables
- 7. Health Service Provider (HSP) Supplemental Survey for 143 community providers: includes information on: HSP site locations, opening hours, priority populations and conditions, geographic catchment areas, funders, CBI, quality improvement
 - Sending data to T/OCHPP and Wellbeing Toronto
