OCHPP Project Goals

- Build community capacity to use health information
- Build a deeper understanding of Ontario at a community-scale in order to appreciate the health needs specific to each area **e.g. vulnerable populations, rates of high disease, identifying priority neighbourhoods**
- Foster academic-hospital-community collaborations to improve population health



OCHPP Project Strategy

- Provide health profiles *of and for* Ontario communities with relevant and timely information in a user-friendly format on the website
- Provide technical support and mechanisms for communities to access data including custom requests for partners ***e.g. development of small area neighbourhoods for Central LHIN***
- Conduct workshops to foster access to and use of health data for decision-making, advocacy and policy, and to stimulate collaboration



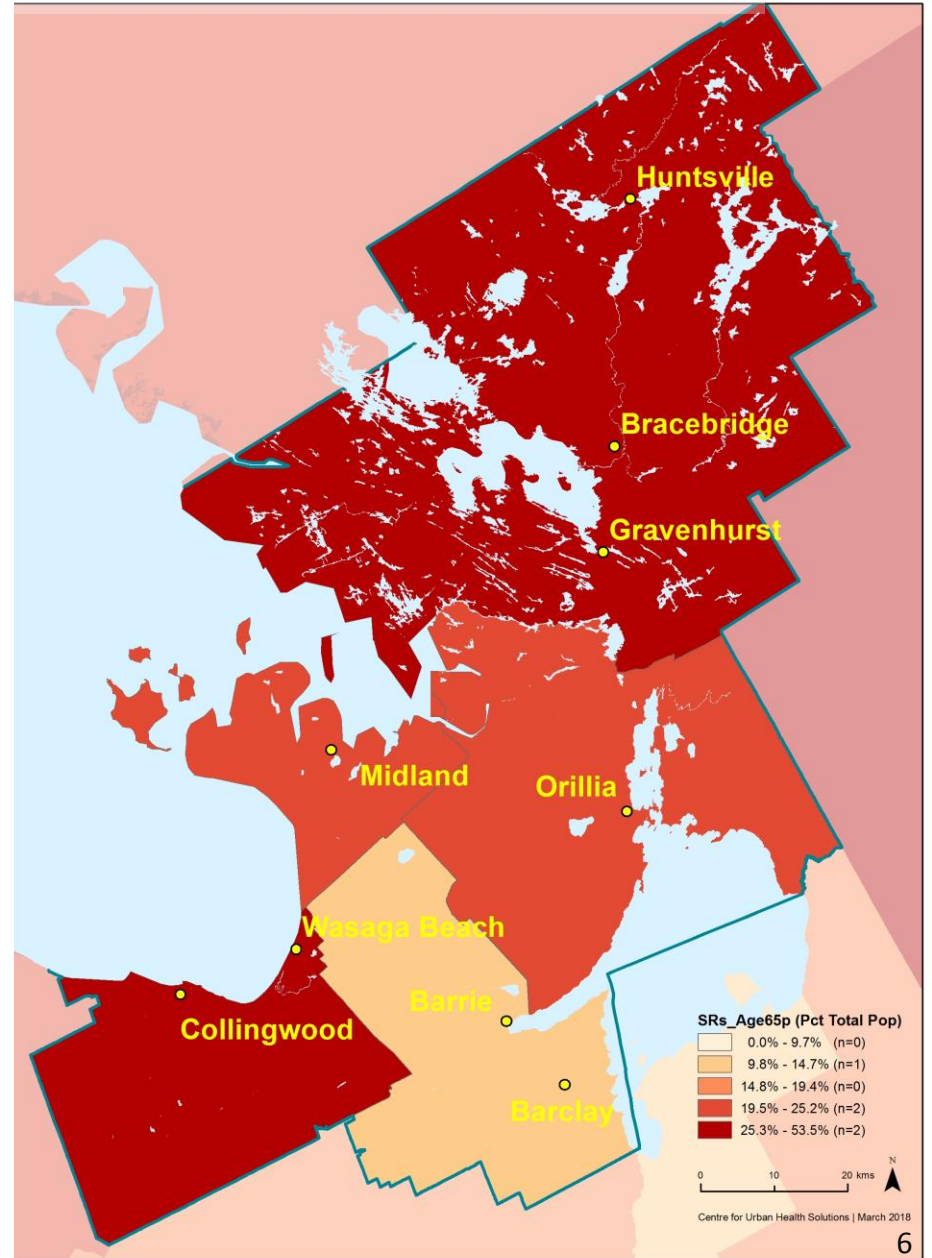
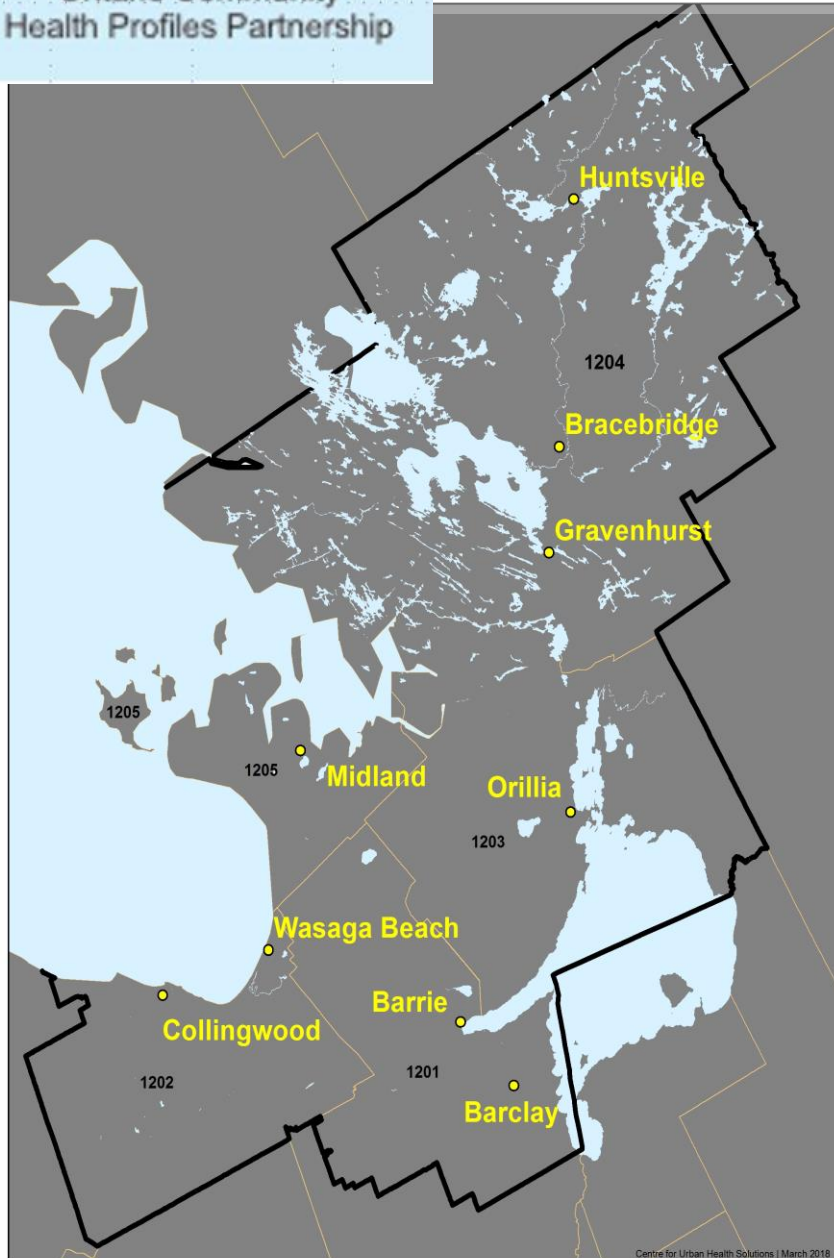
What Information is on the OCHPP Website?

Community-level health indicators - this micro-data provides detailed statistics about populations living in communities by sex and relevant age-groups for each health indicator. We also provide information about how the community compares with the overall geography values and whether this difference is meaningful.

Ontario-wide health indicators - this macro-data provides an overview of how different communities within Ontario compare with each other with respect to specific health indicators.
